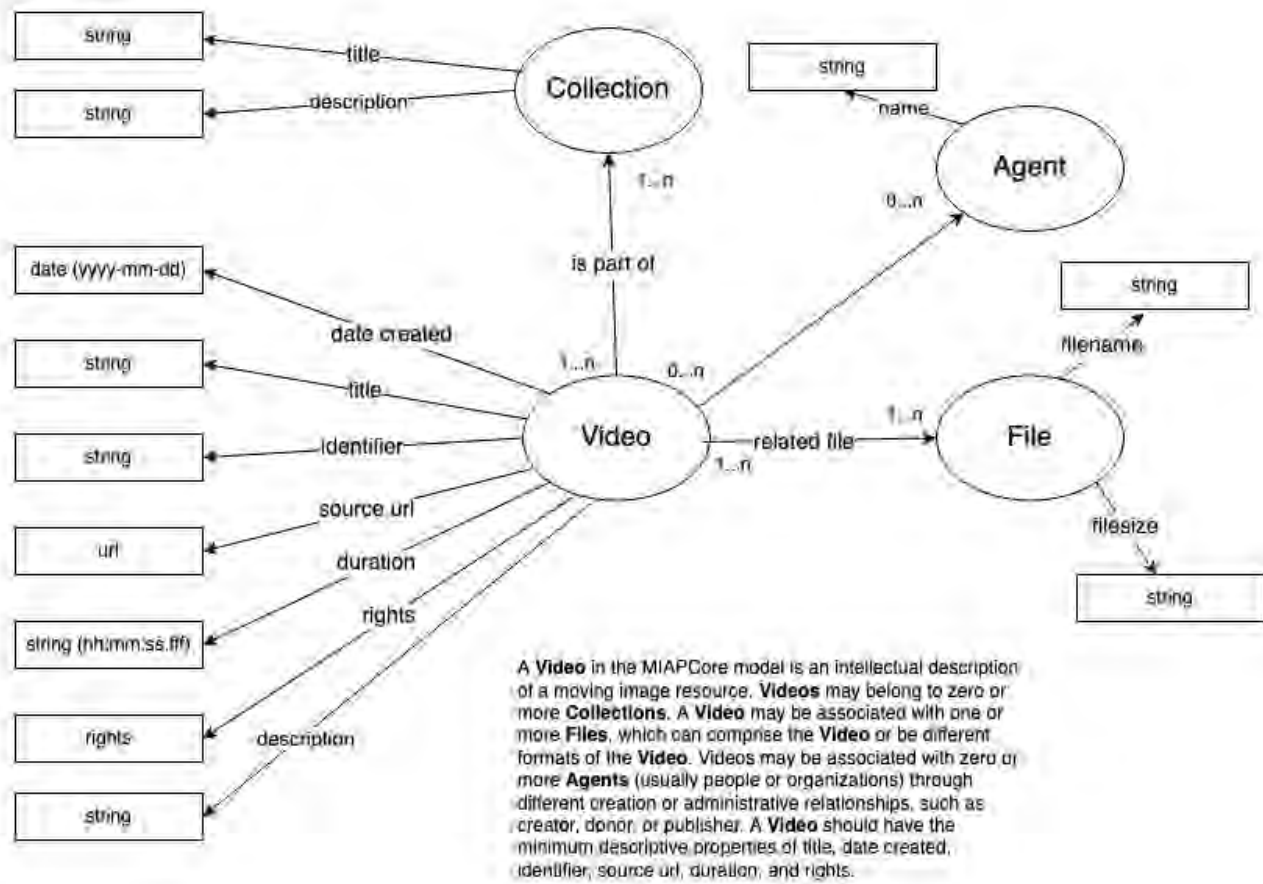


WrestleCore vocabulary

Version 1 (March 2021)

MIAPCore is a basic vocabulary for describing online videos. A Video in the MIAPCore model is an intellectual description of a moving image resource. Videos may belong to zero or more Collections. A Video may be associated with one or more Files, which can comprise the Video or be different formats of the Video. Videos may be associated with zero or more Agents (usually people or organizations) through different creation or administrative relationships, such as creator, donor, or publisher. A Video should have the minimum descriptive properties of title, date created, identifier, source url, duration, and rights.



Reading this profile

The following fields are used to describe each class and property included in the model.

Property name:	Name
Label	The label for the property name
Definition	The definition of the property and how it is used.
Obligation	Specifies if the property is required, recommended, or optional (Required, Recommended, Optional).
Repeatability	Specifies if the property can be used more than once (Yes No).

About the Wrestling Archive:

The Wrestling Archive contains videos of full pro wrestling matches that are available digitally. To define the videos in the collection, first we decided what “Pro” wrestling meant. Not to be confused with sport wrestling as seen in the Olympics, but wrestling as embodied by the current day World Wrestling Entertainment (WWE) company. This includes acrobatics, ostentatious clothing and personas, and normally has some narrative structure. In terms of scope, we are only interested in full wrestling matches, excluding compilations and promotional material, as this would create a catalog of content too vast, but will collect videos from across the world. The collection is important in that it creates an aggregated resource for videos that are spread across the internet in an unorganized manner, and that a multibillion-dollar entertainment industry clearly has a large cultural impact, and we want to make sure these videos are available and accessible for fans and scholars.

Our users include fans and scholars and with a large swath of content, we want to make it easy to search through. Users might be interested in matches from certain dates, countries, or containing different performers or rulesets. Our “stipulations” property helps a user find specific match rules including cage matches, ladder matches, bodybag matches, and lumberjack matches. Other users might be interested in matches just from Mexico and so that is why we created the “country” property.

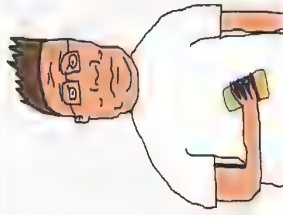

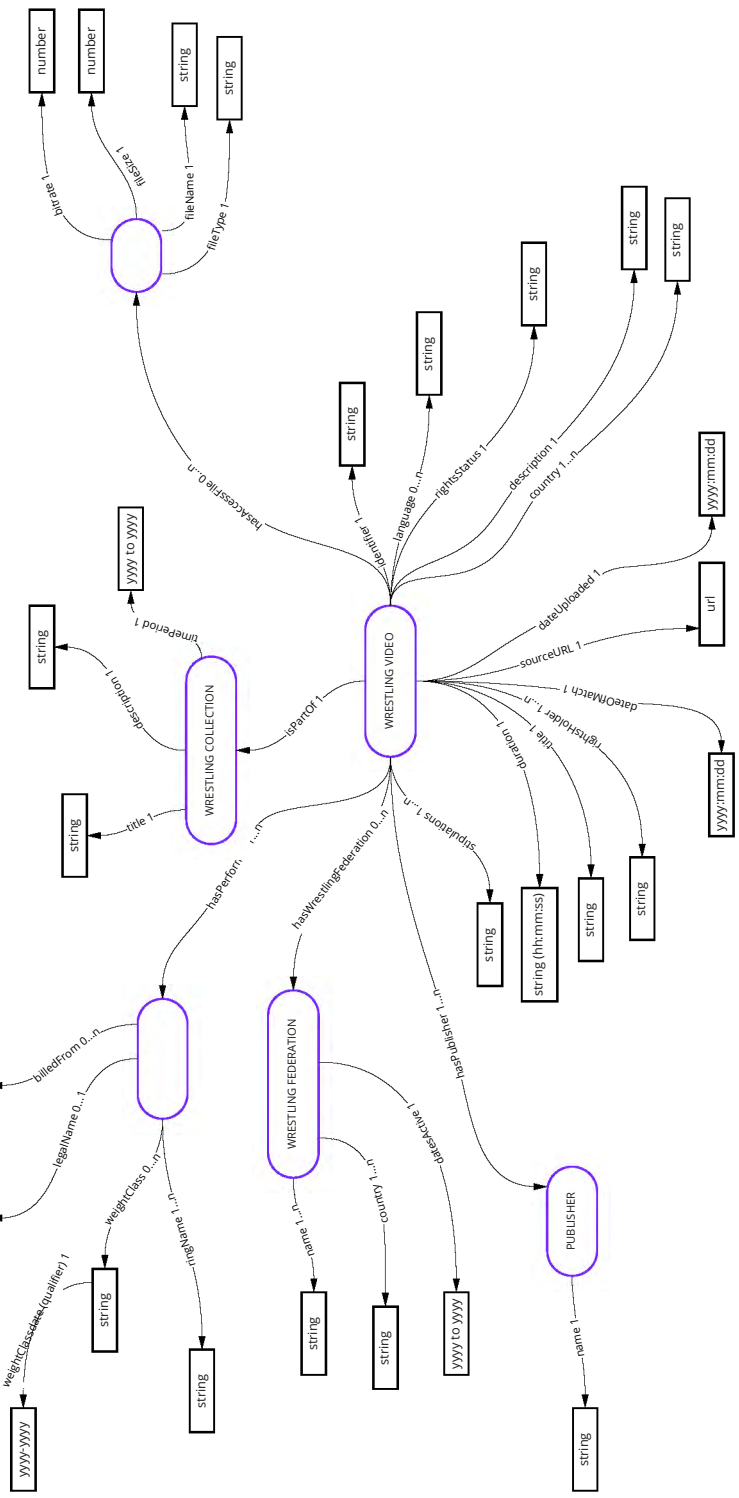

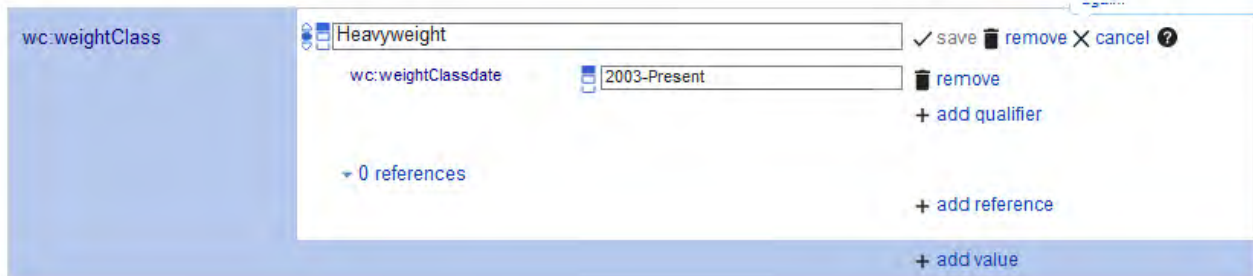

- A VIDEO BELONGS TO ONE COLLECTION
- A VIDEO MAY HAVE ONE OR MORE ASSOCIATED ACCESS FILES
- A VIDEO MAY HAVE MULTIPLE AGENTS
 - AGENTS INCLUDE:
 - PERFORMERS IN VIDEO
 - PUBLISHER OF VIDEO
 - ASSOCIATED WRESTLING FEDERATION
- VIDEO MUST INCLUDE AT LEAST THE FOLLOWING PROPERTIES
 - TITLE, DATE OF MATCH, URL, DURATION, DESCRIPTION, AND IDENTIFIER



WrestlingCore Cataloging Guidelines

1. Establish what video you will be cataloging.
2. Create Item utilizing the title of the video as its name and define it as an instance of both a miap:video and wc:Wrestlingvideo
 - a. Establish it is part of Pro Wrestling Collection
 - b. Follow guidelines and vocabulary based on WrestleCore found here:

 - c. Special things to note:
 - i. Title: Utilize the title found on the website
 - ii. Description: Utilize the description found in the video description on the source website. If description exceeds the character limit, use best judgement when omitting information. Try to retain any mention of event names, dates, federations, or performers. Feel free to omit social media tags.
 - iii. Stipulations: Stipulations are used to describe not only specific rules or regulations i.e. knockout, tag team, royal rumble, etc. but also the types of participants allowed, ie men, women, or mixed. Please note that not all matches have stipulations, and is considered an optional field. Please see the controlled vocabulary section of this property. If having trouble locating any stipulations, they are normally in the title, description, or the first 5 minutes of the match, normally when the performers are introduced. If you cannot find anything, it is safe to assume that it is at least a knockout match.
 - iv. Identifier: Please ask the WrestleCore collection group for an id number
 - v. Duration: Taken from video start to video end, includes introduction spots and any other content surrounding the match within the video.
 - vi. Rights: Use statement and not URI. Look for any copyright notices within the description or title of the video. If not immediately apparent, feel free to use "Copyright Not Evaluated"
 - vii. Country: Utilize MARC code. Note that some videos might have more than one associated country, for example a US based federation might hold a tournament with a Japanese bracket.
 - viii. Language: Utilize MARC code. Note some content may be silent, so language may not be applicable.
 - d. Pause to add the following properties: miap:relatedFile, wc:hasPublisher, wc:hasPerformer, and wc:hasWrestlingfederation, as you now must create Items to link back to this video
3. Create File utilizing the ID number + file extension as its name, eg WA_99999999.mp4
 - a. Follow vocab guidelines and add the appropriate properties (note for the in class exercise feel free to make these values up)
4. Link this new File Item on the video page utilizing the property miap:relatedFile

5. Find the associated wrestling federation (defined in the vocab under wc:Wrestlingfederation), follow step 5.a if already exists, follow step 5.b if not
 - a. Link the federation to the video using the property wc:hasWrestlingfederation
 - b. Create new Item using federation name as the name
 - i. Follow guidelines
 - ii. Link to video using process in 5.a
6. Find associated performers defined in vocab under wc:Performer. Follow step 6a if already exists, follow 6.b if not. **Please note that a new Item must be created for each performer in the video, so you might be making multiple items at this time. We would recommend finishing one performer before moving on to the next.**
 - a. Link the federation to the video using the property wc:hasPerformer
 - b. Create new Item using performer's ring name within the current video
 - i. Follow guidelines
 - ii. **Special note about wc:weightclass:** Sometimes the weight class is not given during the video so some outside research is required. If the performer's weight class is found, add the property wc:weightclass and add wc:weightclassdate as a **qualifier** to the property. Weight classes are not always fixed and so we are trying to provide date ranges in the format of yyyy-yyyy or yyyy-Present. See below image for example of adding a qualifier to the weight class property:

7. Go to Pro-Wrestling Collection and add the video utilizing miap:hasRecord
